### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgment that PCV/PCA rules apply and acceptance of these rules.

A riders age is taken from **1st September 2022** as per Sporting Horse Rules, Before riding all Non-Pony Club members, and any Pony Club member who cannot show their Pony Club card or prove Pony Club membership must complete the day participant waiver and liability declaration. Failure do so will result in elimination. Non-Pony Club members and PCA/PCV members who cannot prove their PCA/PCV membership must pay \$20 per day of participation unless exempt by way of holding insurance (as per Page 2 - Liability Declaration) with an equine organization or hold their own insurance.

PCV club member cards must be inspected on the day at the office before riding. Failure do so will result in elimination

PCV Insurance Policy specifically states anyone not following PCV Rules may be left uninsured.

**No refunds** after tickets have been purchased.

The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.

Competitors may ride more than one horse, subject to the conditions of the current PCV *Handbook of By-laws* multiple horse rules.

**Gear Check** – required for all riders before competing as per November 2022 PCA Gear Rules. HELMETS: Complying helmets must be worn (ASSA3838 standard, EN1384 standard plus the VG1 standard, ASTHF1163 standard, ARB HS 2012 standard, PAS 015 BSI Kite marked.

Dogs allowed, must be leashed and kept under control at all times.

Horses must be at least age four, no stallions, colts or rigs.

PCV Alcohol Policy and NO SMOKING policy applies. This means no smoking is allowed on the grounds

Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.

Judge's decision is final. No protests will be entered into.
